### Rules and Regulations

- Riders do not have to be members to compete for High Point Day Awards. Must be members to compete for year end awards.
- It is highly recommended that ALL show participants carefully read the RULEBOOK.
- A Coggins test within 1 year is required.
- Entries must scratch AT LEAST 3 classes in advance to receive a refund; class may only be scratched ONE TIME for refund.
- Youth 17 years and under
- Adult 18 years and over
- Working Western Classes will be judged by the American Ranch Horse Assoc. Rules - with slight modifications.
- Future Entry is a rider who must have an assistant while riding. Future Entry riders may not cross enter into any other classes. Points from this division will be based on the rider only.
- Academy Entry is considered a beginner rider: someone who has been showing for less than 2 years except for the Future Entry classes. Riders in this division must be under riding instruction on their own horse or a lesson horse. Points from this division will be based on the rider only.
- A novice rider is a rider who has shown less than 4 years, not including showing in the Future Entry Division. All riders age 10 and under are considered novices.
- A green horse is a horse that is in their 1st or 2nd year of showing.
- No cross entry between Stock Type, Field Type and Saddle Pleasure Type and Miniature Equine.
- Safe riding apparel is required. Shoes with heel, pants (no shorts) and shirt with at least a 4" sleeve. Safety helmets permitted in any class but are required in all jump classes and on all riders age 12 and under when mounted.
- A GAYP or Go as you please class includes a walk and then any other gait desired by the rider. Same gaits in both directions.
- SG means Secondary Gait (trot, jog or pleasure gait). The pleasure gait is for non-trotting breeds
- Hoof band are not permitted on the show grounds. Action devices such as chains,

rollers, etc and those similar are not permitted.
